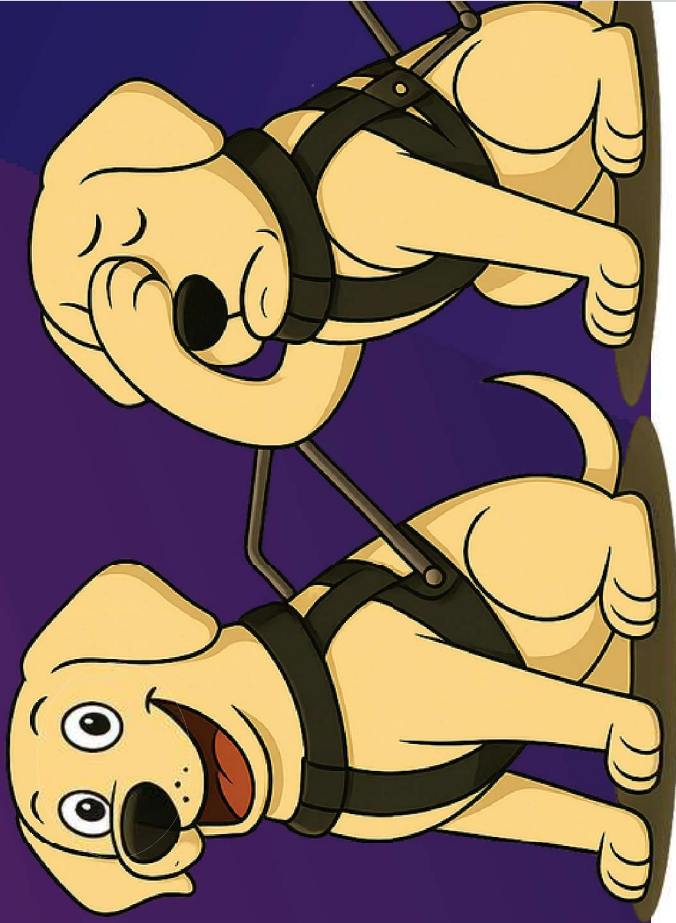
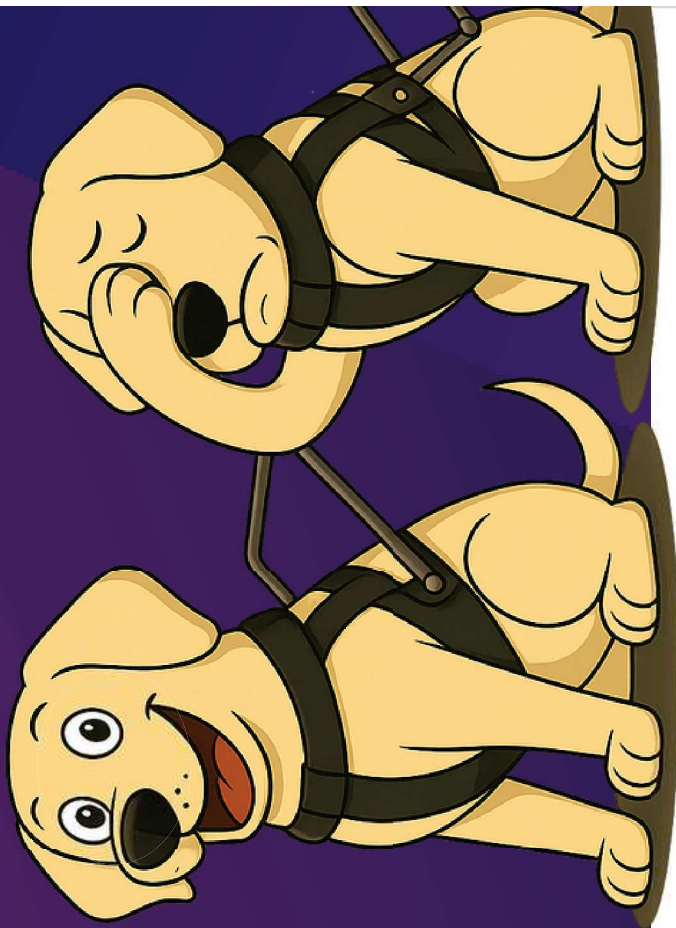

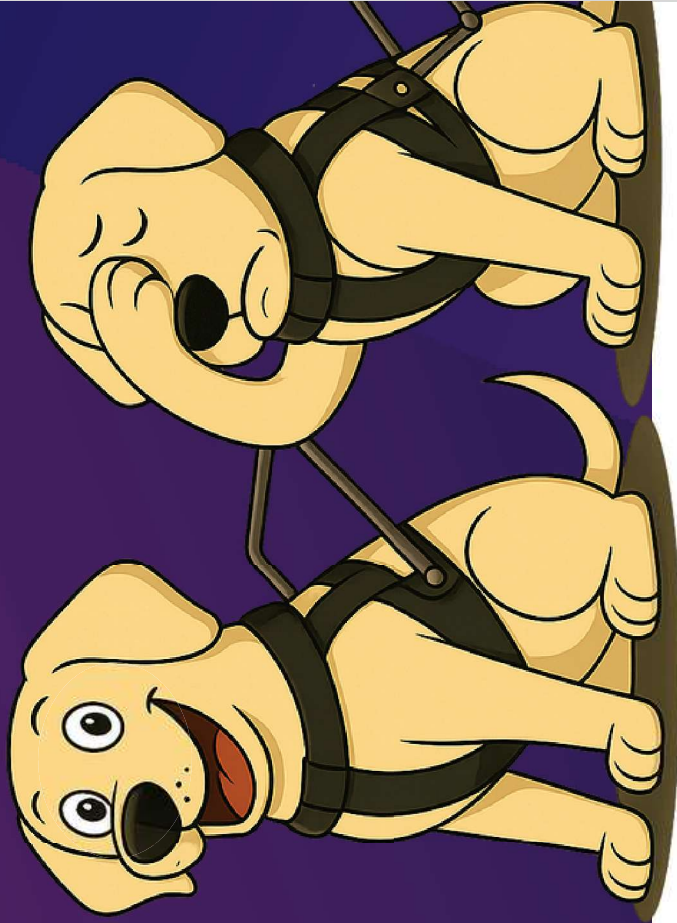
**Touching the harness interferes with guiding and can put the handler in danger.**



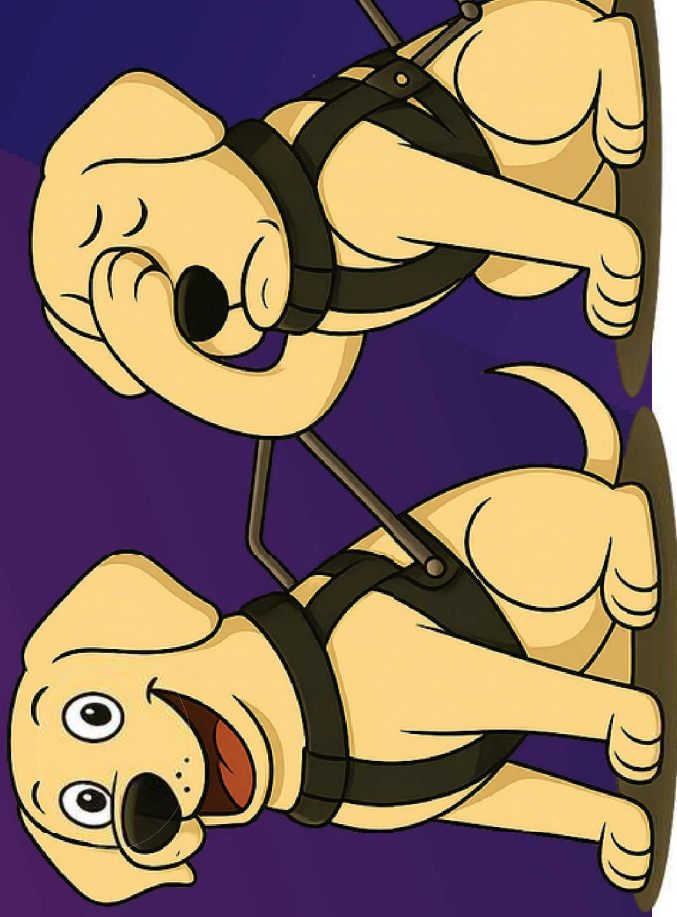

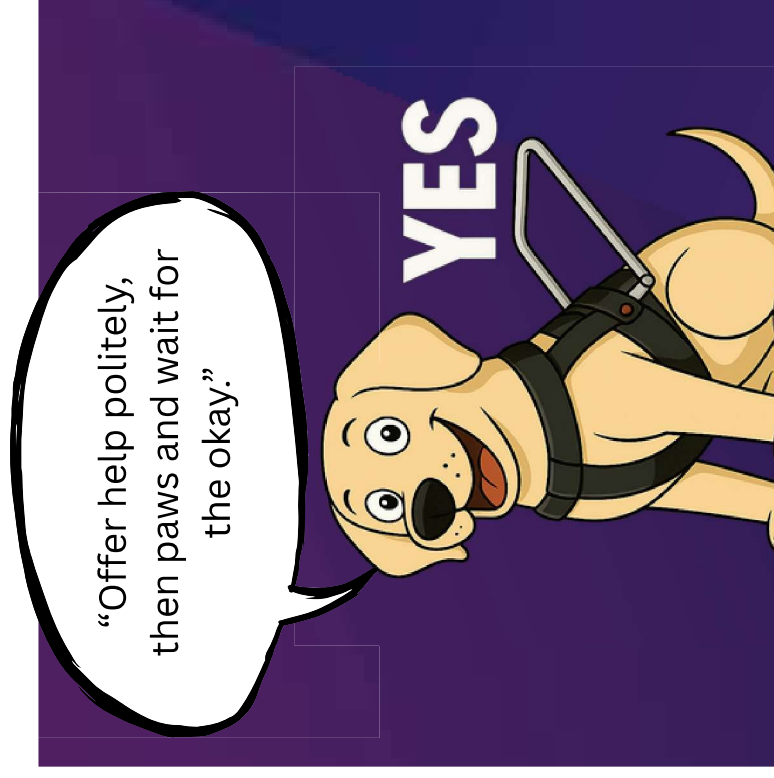
**The harness means the dog is working. Touching it interferes with guiding.**

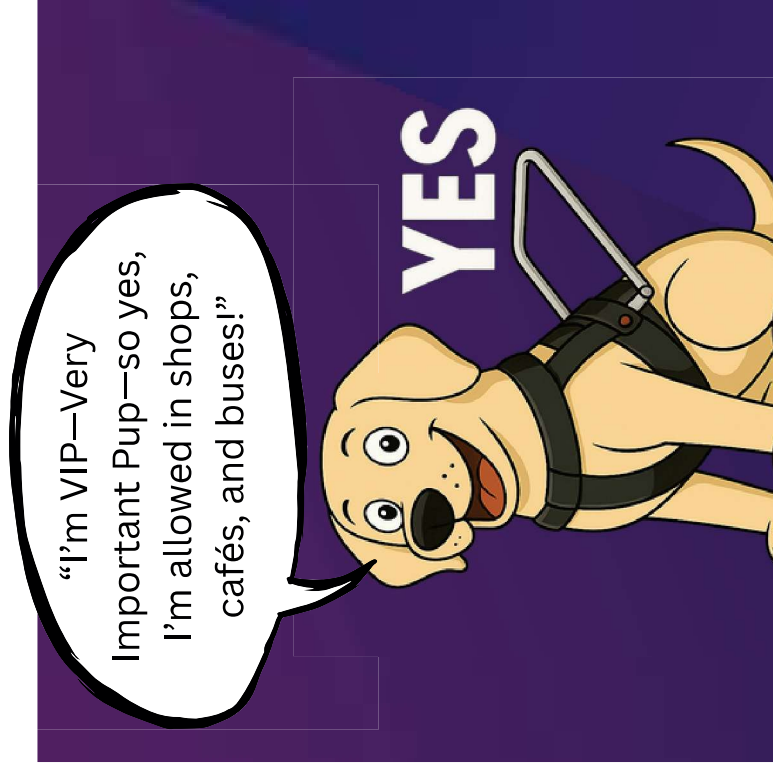
**Unleashed dogs can distract or harm a guide dog. Space keeps everyone safe.**

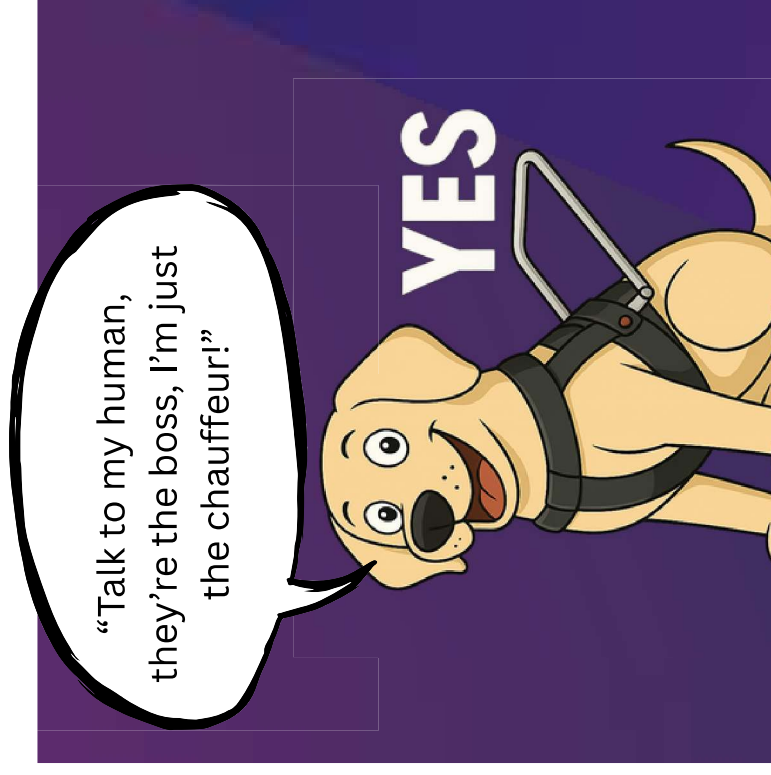
**Grabbing the dog or harness can confuse or endanger the handler. Offer help politely.**
